### Automatic Call

If the closing level of the Basket on the Review Date is greater than or equal to the Call Value, the notes will be automatically called for a cash payment, for each \$1,000 principal amount note, equal to (a) \$1,000 plus (b) the Call Premium Amount, payable on the Call Settlement Date. No further payments will be made on the notes

If the notes are automatically called, you will not benefit from the Upside Leverage Factor that applies to the payment at maturity if the Final Basket Value is greater than the Initial Basket Value. Because the Upside Leverage Factor does not apply to the payment upon an automatic call, the payment upon an automatic call may be significantly less than the payment at maturity for the same level of appreciation in the Basket. 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# Payment At Maturity

If the notes have not been automatically called and the Final Basket Value is greater than the Initial Basket Value, your payment at maturity per \$1,000 principal amount note will be calculated as follows: \$1,000 + (\$1,000 × Basket Return × Upside Leverage Factor)

If the notes have not been automatically called and the Final Basket Value is equal to the Initial Basket Value, you will receive the principal amount of your notes at maturity. If the notes have not been automatically called and the Final Basket Value is less than the Initial Basket Value, your payment at maturity per

\$1,000 principal amount note will be calculated as follows
